TRAJECTORIES OF RUSSIA'S ECONOMIC MODERNISATION

Russia's economy is at a crucial juncture – the focus on industrial policy and import-substitution may have given rise to concerns in the West that the paradigm of trade and investment openness in Russia's economic policy is lost. But notwithstanding the current adverse external environment of slowing global economy and lower oil prices, Russia is forging ahead with measures in external and domestic economic policy that leave some room for hope. Furthermore, the severity of the global environment may produce precisely the changes in Russia's economic structure that it failed to achieve in the preceding decades – the dependency on oil is starting to decline, while productivity and cost-cutting is starting to acquire greater weight in economic policy objectives. What is the future of Russia's economy in the "new world" of lower oil prices and what will that bring to the Russia-Europe relationship?
